



## CHARTER

In order that



No participant be allowed to handle family conflicts if he or she is not driven by benevolence and the desire to find solutions;



Children be assured that the difficulties experienced by their parents are taken care of; they do not be the stakes of separations of the people who take care of them; and they be assured to have the right to continue to have close relationships with all those who took care of them, regardless of the link of civil status existing between them;



Parents obtain help and support in situations of transition or crisis such as the creation or breakdown of a family; they feel supported by professionals who only have the interest of the family in mind; they be helped in the immense difficulty that a marital or emotional break-up may represent, and in particular be helped to forgive each other to be able to help one another in their role as parents with benevolence, by distinguishing their emotional life from their parental life, in order to be responsible adults and parents;



Grandparents, second spouses, partners and all those who aspire to be taken into account by Justice, be heard and associated to the agreements which relate to them, and that they be thus assured to keep their family ties;



We have decided to unite our efforts, to pool our practices and skills, and to work in a multidisciplinary manner at the service of families, in order to promote the coherence and the effectiveness of agreements which will foster the self-fulfillment of their members and the persistence of ties beyond break-ups and bereavements.
